Missouri Rural Water Association Video Contest Official Contest Rules and Registration

The Challenge: Create a 60 second video based on the following theme:
“Where Does My Drinking Water Come From”

Creatively show where your local water comes from, and why/how your local water or wastewater system is involved.

USE YOUR IMAGINATION!

Who is Eligible: The contest is open to all students, individually or as a group entry of no more than four students. Entries may be from Missouri Public, Private, or Home Schools. Entries must be sponsored by an individual teacher representing a specific department within your school. Each school may create as many video’s as they have groups, however each school may only submit one entry to Missouri Rural Water Association as a contest entry.

The Sponsoring System: Each entry must be sponsored by a water or wastewater system who is a member of Missouri Rural Water Association.

The Sponsoring Teacher: The sponsor’s role is to encourage students’ participation and provide guidance in how to plan a video and enter the contest – not in developing the creative concept or executing the video. Any teacher may serve as the sponsor, but the award must go to a designated department. (for example, FFA, Athletic Department, Band, etc.)

The Video: The video must be no longer than 60 seconds. **No copyrighted material can be used in the creation of your video.** The video must be saved on a disc in MPEG-2, MPEG4, 3GPP, MOV, AVI, WMV, or FLV format only.

NO burned copies with a choose to start option, the video must be saved as a file.

The Timeframe: Videos must be postmarked to the Missouri Rural Water Association before February 1, 2013.

The Award: The winning entry will receive \$500 paid directly to the school’s sponsoring teacher/department, specifically for that department and \$500 to be divided between the team.

Judging: Judging will be conducted by MRWA staff and attendees at selected MRWA events. Entries will be judged on creativity, effective communication, quality of execution, and compliance with contest rules.

The Winner: The winning sponsor will be notified by email and/or phone after judging occurs (all entries will be notified).

The Fame: MRWA will list all eligible entries on youtube.com and the winning entry will be showcased online on Missouri Rural Water Association websites, MRWA Conferences, and in educational materials throughout the year.
