The T-A School invites students to its 3-on-3 Basketball Tournament coming up May 20, 2017. Below are the rules we will use and the entry form. Please feel free to copy as needed. Entry form and money are due by May 17th. A completed, signed form and money must be submitted for a team can play. Medals will be given to the winners of each division. There will be a concession stand.

TA 3-on-3 Rules

Pre-Game:

- Upon arrival, please report to the check-in table. A copy of the rules will be available.
- A forfeit will occur unless there are at least two players present at game time.
- No more than 5 min for warm up
- NO DUNKING is allowed during warm ups or between games
- All Teams must have one score keeper during each game

Scoring & Time outs, Possessions:

- Games consist of 21 points or 15 minutes running clock (whichever comes first). Each team will be allowed 1 30 second time out per game.
- Substitutes may enter during any dead ball situations.
- Field goals will count 2 or 3 points accordingly.
- All out of bounds situations will be inbounded from top of the circle.
- The in bounder may dribble or pass the ball to begin play.
- A coin toss will determine first possession.
- The ball must be checked on inbounds situations and after made baskets.
- The ball must be cleared (but not checked) beyond the 3 point line after defensive rebounds and steals.

Fouls:

- Players are disqualified on the fourth personal or first technical foul.
- If a foul is called while a player is attempting a shot and the basket is made then count the basket, record the foul, and no foul shot is awarded. A point will be awarded for all fouls unless the shot is made.
- Continual misconduct or flagrant fouling will result in immediate dismissal of player from the tournament.
