





The following is some general information and rules for our tournament.

- 1. The **tournament dates** are Monday through Friday, **March 13-17, 2017**. Final games for both girls and boys to be held on Friday March 17, 2017
- 2. A gate admission will be charged. School sport passes will not be accepted. No admission will be charged for preschool aged and younger children. Prices: Adults \$3.00, Senior Citizens \$2.00, Students \$1.00.
- 3. Coaches, players, and anyone else will not be charged admission as long as they are on the pass list. Please have everyone on the pass list identify themselves at the entrance gate.
- 4. Coaches and teams need be present 30 min. prior to their scheduled games.
- 5. There will be 5-minute quarter for first round games. The remaining games will have 6-minute quarters.
- 6. Time Outs. Each team will have 3 time outs per half. 2 time outs @ 30 sec. 1 time out @ 60 sec.
- 7. It is up to each team to provide their own stat keeper for each game they play. BHMS will have an official score and time keeper and will be located at the scoreboard table.
- 8. Pressing will only be allowed in the 4th Quarter. In the 4th Quarter if a team gets a ten point advantage they will need to call off the press. Each team will get one warning about pressing after that, the team will be in violation and be given a team foul for the pressing infraction. This may occur in any quarter.
- 9. Warm-up balls will be furnished for each team.
- 10. Referees have been scheduled and will consist of licensed and nonlicensed officials. Their decision(s) will be final. We appreciate your cooperation with all volunteers and enlisted help.
- 11. Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and consolation.
- 12. Good sportsmanship is expected to be shown at all times by all players. coaches, and fans. Any team who shows poor sportsmanship may be subjected to a team foul, personal foul, or even a technical foul depending on the severity.
- 13. A concession stand will be available. Please do not bring refreshments into the building. Players will be allowed to bring water or sports drinks and may have them at their teams bench. Water bottles are also allowed.
- 14. Remember we are a Parochial school and support Christian values. We believe that all people are created in the image and likeness of God, therefore we believe that all participants should be able to participate and that all coaches and spectators should create a positive atmosphere for everyone involved.
